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

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereis) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322: Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lian Imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such (liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of labor of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Linechanic's Henor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof epitch meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been fligo by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice reterred to in sub-· bellt ed liada (a) notices

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision, as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or in:angible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has anot by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subcurregraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the flen is situated in the District of Counties 3.2 Co. 9.1009 N.5 F (B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, circular tangible or intangible, at the residence of the texpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partn rahip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive effice of the business is located, and the residence of a fact ever whose residence is without the United States shall be deer led to be in the District or Columbia.

(3) Form - The 'orm and content of the mostice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice sar in by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of iten.

(f) General Rule, - Unless notice of ilen is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliting period, such notice of lien shall be transed as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such rafiling paripd.

(2) Place For FHIng. - A notice of Jien reflied during the required refiling period shall be effective only -(A) II -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of tien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (I) (4), and

(3) Required Refilling Period, — in the case of any notice of ligh, the term "required refilling period" means (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required patiting period for such notice of tien.

Lien Sec. 6325. Release Of Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall facus a cartificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become lagally unenforceable; or

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(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and ac sorted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of he amount assessed, together with all Interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements races at to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thy eor, as may be appolited by such regulations.

(2) Discipaure of amount of outstanding lies - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes actisfactory written syldence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property. 15 1 13

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
