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

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Gode

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neplects of refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien favor of the United States upon till property and rights to property, whether real or persons belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322? Period Of Lien.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Parsons.

(a) Rurchaser's, Holders Of Sectifity Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. — The sentengosed by section 6321 shall not be falld as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, forthanks sentor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.--

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real propurty, in one office within the State (or the county, or other or immunital, subdivision), as designated by the laws of six h State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien it situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is siturated, whenever 12 I State has not by law designated one office which meets the reculirements of subparacraph (A), or

(C) With Ricorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Cillumbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Cillumbia, if the property subject to the Sen is situated in the District of

Columbia ([C]] 3 f [[

(Z) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated:

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the

taxp yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

Fir purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation of part are by shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal condition of the business is located, and the residence of a flux ayer whose residence is without the United States shall be for used to be in the District of Columbia.

- (3) Form of the folia and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice that be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law related to the form or content of a notice of flen.

- (a) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section—
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflect in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of lien shall be trialled as filled on the date or which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of lien refised during the required refixing period shall be effective only.

 (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reflicing is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

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Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence. If a notice of such lien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of tien, the term required refiling period means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expitation of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (b) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the praceding required refiling period for—(such notice of Sen. —

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(i) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, while the time prescribed by law (including amount on of much time), and that is in accordance with such requirement of the bond and surstier one, on, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103 Confidentiality and Disclosure (1 f.eturns and Return intormation.

Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes:

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lists - If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who fainishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
