SECTION 3. The vacation here in provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the LaSalle National Bank, as Trustee. Trust No. 21038-09, successor to Exchange National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee. Trust No. 21038 shall pay or cause to be poid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owner of the property abutting said part of public alley hereby vacated, the sum of Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen and no/100 Dollars (\$16.819.00), which sum in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits; and further, shall within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, deposit in the City Treasury of the City of Chicago a sum sufficient to defrive the costs of removing paving and curb returns and constructing sidewalk and curb across the entrance to that part of the public alley hereby vacated, similar to the sidewalk and curb in S. Sangamon Street.

The precise amount of the sum so deposited shall be ascertained by the Commissioner of Public Works after such investigation as is requisite.

SECTION 4. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the LaSalle National Bank, as Trustee. Trust No. 21038-09, successor to Exchange National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee. Trust No. 21038 shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by the Superintendent of Maps.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
