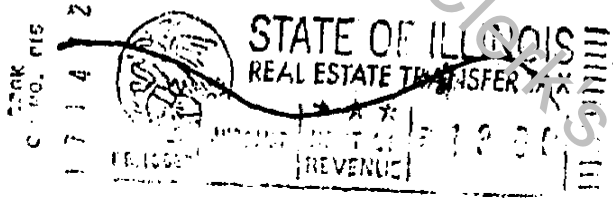

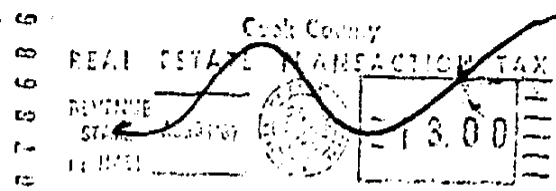

The recording process involves the filing of a document with the Clerk's Office, which then records the document and issues a recording certificate. The recording certificate is a document that certifies that the document has been recorded and provides information about the recording, such as the recording date and the recording number. The recording certificate is then returned to the filer of the document. The recording process is a public process, and the recording certificate is available to the public for inspection.

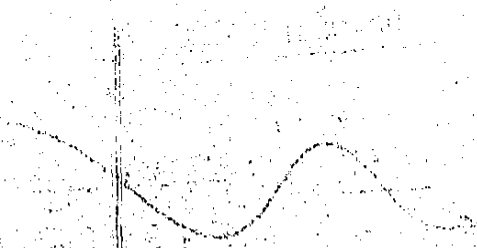
