## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Codo

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laose of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests;-Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. -- The tien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, milichanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

## (f) Prace For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the ilen is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governments) subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Ot District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the Judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Geods of the District of Columbia. the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Ot Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at 'ts physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, win ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tax ayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or per ner hip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal e oculys office of the business is located, and the residence of the payer whose residence is without the United States shall be de imed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The 107h and content of the notice referred to in substittion (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a

(a) Retiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lieft is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated earlied on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of lian relied during the required retiting deriod spart be effective only -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was fried, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, SO days or more prior to the date of a reliting of notice of hen under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence. If a notice of such tien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is rocated.

(3) Required Reliling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refitling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Release Of Lien Or Sec. 6325. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days affer the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

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(2) Bond Acconted - There is furnished to the Secretary and recepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of il e amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements stating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suretica thirden, as may be specified by such regulations.

(b) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding from - If a notice of Hen has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such fren may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such hen or intends to obtain a right in such property.
