Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

il any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition therefol shall be she have set the favor of this timined States upon all property and rights a chapachy; affective real or personal, the longing to the such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically lived by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority

Against Certain Persons. Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors. —The Hen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
