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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED:

- 1. Mortgagoes shall (1) peomptly repoir, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or bereafter on the permises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said permises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics or other liens or thirm for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) may when due any indebtedness which may be accured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to hedders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of execution upon said premises. (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the one thereof; (5) make no material afterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Mortgagers shall pay before any pendity attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special saxes ments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor. All moneys paid for any of the purposes bearin authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attenneys fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trostee or the holders of the note to protect the mortgaged premiers and the lies hereof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and parable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, Inaction of Trustee or holders of the note shall never he considered as a waiter of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereundes on the part of Mortgagors.
- 5. - 10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
 - 1]. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to impect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be per inited for that purpose.
- 12. Truster has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Truster be obligated to rice d this trust deed or to exercise any power berein given unless expressly obligated by the terms bereof, nor be liable for any acts or employees of Truster, and it may require indemnities satusfactory to it before exercising any power berein given.
- 13. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by peoper-instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebted eas so used by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may exerute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, p odors to "rabible to Trustee the note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which represents in Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of "in original or a successor trustee, such trustee may accept as the genuine note berein described any note which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which proposes to be executed by the persons berein designated as the makers thereof.
- 14. Truster may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or file. It case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds, of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust.
