GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable on isideration, Grantor mortgages, and warrants and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and findness all easements, royalties, appurtenances, all rights relating to the real property (including minerals oil, gas, water, and the like), and all dischinghts (including stock in utilities with dischior irrigation rights) located a) Dupage County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property") and legally described as:

Indebtedness. Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the real property described above in the "Grant of Mortpage" section

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include any promissory notes, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements and all other documents executed in connection with this Mortgage or the indebtedness, whether now or hereafter existing

Rents. The word "Rents" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, and profits from the Real Property and the Personal Property

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THE HOTE AND THIS MORTGAGE AND IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that its possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been and never will be so long as this Mortgage ternains alien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous substance as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Dability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), applicable state laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to either of the foregoing. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this provision of the Mortgage. This obligation to indemnify shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and satisfaction of this Mortgage.

Nuisance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof, including without finitation removal, or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or soil, or gravel or rock products.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. Lender shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace any improvements which Grantor proposes to remove with improvements of at least ergual value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the importance of compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate applicable, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or surety bond (reasonably satisfactory to Lender) to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may at its option duclare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest, herein, without the Lender's prior written consent. A "sale or transfer means the conveyance of real property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legit or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; by outright sale; deed; installment sale contract; land contract; contract for deed; leasehold interest with a felling greater than three years; lease-option contract; sale, assignment or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes, special trues, assessments, water charges and sewer senne charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work during on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and essessments not due, except for the prior indeptedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of n inpayment. Grantor shall within 15 days after the fien arises or, if a lien is filed, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount outficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, afterneys' fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as at additional obligee under any sureshound furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least 15 days before any work is commenced any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanics, materialmens, or other construction behicould be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$10,000.00. Grantor will on request furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endots aments on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. In no event shall the insurance be in an amount less than \$120,000 00. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss of Grantor tails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to pay any amounts owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Lender

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holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall mure to the benefit of, and pass to the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance With Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior Indebtedness.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain prior indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would, affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender may at its option, on Grantor's behalf take the required action and any amount that if expends in so doing shall be added to the indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the date of expenditure until paid at the rate of 9,990% per annum. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. By taking the required action, Lender shall not cure the default so as to bar if from any remedy that if otherwise would have had

WARRANTY: DEFENSE OF TITLE.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above. Grantor warrants and will forever defend the tot he Property against the Lawful claims of all persons. In the event (any action or proceeding to commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage. Grantor shall defend the action at its explore. Grantor may be the normal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from the to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that its sent the Property complies with all existing applicable laws profinances, and regulations of governmenta authorities.

PRIOR INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concer sing prior indebtedness are a part of this Mortgage

Prior Lien. Grantor has informed Lender of the existence of a lien in the form of independence. One, which may have priority to the lien of this Mongage. The obligation secured by the prior lien has a current principal of claims of approximately \$102,397,00 and is in the original principal amount of \$120,000,00 Grantor expressly coverants and agrees to pay or see to the plantiers of the prior indeptedness and to prevent any default thereunder.

Default. If the payment of any installment of principal or any interest on the prior indebtedness is not made within the time required by the note evidending such indebtedness, or should an event of default occur under the in item securing such indebtedness and not be dured during any applicable grace period therein, then the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall at the option of Lender, become immediately due and payable, and this Mortgage shall be in default.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under a prior mortgage, deed or trust, or other security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

CONDEMNATION.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its existion require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award that it her payment of all reasonable costs, expenses and attorneys' less necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, or Lender in connection with the condemns income

Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAX BY STATE.

Remedies. SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Blinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. 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Addresses. The malling address of Grantor (debtor) and the mailing address of Lender (secured party) from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code) are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage and the Note, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortoage within the preceding 12 months, it may be cured (and no event of default will have occurred) if Grantor, after receiving written notice from Lender demanding cure of such failure: (r, cures the failure within 15 days) or (b) if the cure requires more than 15 days), immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter consumues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or futnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect

Insolvency. The insolvency or orun, or, appointment of a receiver for any part of Granton's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding unriar any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a busin est). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Illinois law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an event of default un ser this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foredristile, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, tepossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property, however time of usection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness. of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surely bond for the claim satisfactory to Lander.

Leasehold Default. If the interest of Grantor in the Property is a leasehold interest, any default by Grantor under the terms of the lease, or any other event (whether or not the fault of Grantor) that results in the ie mination of Grantor's leasehold rights

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the full soil any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agricultent concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Gramor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guaranters. Any of the preceding events occur with risplict to any guaranter of any of the indebtedness or such guaranter dies or becomes incompetent, unless the obligations arising under the guaranty and elated agreements have been unconditionally assumed by the guarantor's estate in a manner satisfactory to Lender.

Insecurity. If Lander reasonably deems itself insecure.

Prior Indebtedness. Default of Grantor under any prior obligation or instrument securing any prior obligation, or commencement of any suit or other action to foreclose any prior lien on the Property.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any event of default and at any time thereafter, Lender may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declar, the entire indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prapayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Minois Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and Left of the Rents, including amounts pasticue and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and apply elember's costs, abainst the impetitedness. In furth kande of this right, Lember may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of cent or use fees greatly to Lender. If the Rents are reflected by Lender then Grantor artevocably designates. Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations. for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foredocure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The morpages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the 🚺 apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Granton's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Nonfudicial Sale. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may foreclose Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Personal Property or the Real Prope by nonjudicial sale.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or by law.

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Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be tree to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least 10 days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage. Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at that and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law. STAT., CH. 110 SECTION 15-1601(b) OR ANY SIMILAR LAW EXISTING AFTER THE DATE OF THIS MORTGAGE, ANY AND ALL RIGHTS OF FEDEMPTION ON BEHALF OF GRANTOR AND ON BEHALF OF ANY OTHER PERSONS PERMITTED TO REDEEM THE PREMISES.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in the Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If unnership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lander, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the indebtedness by way of torbestance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage in the indebtedness.
