Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crise

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

if any person flable to pay any lax neglects or refuses to pay the same efter demand, the arrount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to 'ax, or assessable penalty. together with any costs that may accrus in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322: Period Of Lien.

tinious another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lance of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic alienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which means the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Searstary.

(n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be fried -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designand by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(iii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangitie or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lier is situated, whenever the State has anot by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds DI The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Hen is situated in the bistrict of 70 6: 116: 119 Сомлория

(2) Shus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location: or

(8) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. hether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxy eyer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

Fur purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par nerr tip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal at acultys office of the business is located, and the residence ut a lar payer whose residence is without the United States shall be us imed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The post and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice ah ... be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law repairing the form or content of a natice of lien.

(g) Retiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section

(1) General Rule. - Untess notice of tien is relifed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (Z) during the required ratiling period, such notice at lian shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (1)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Piace For Filing. - A notice of tien refiled during the required retiling period shall be effective only

(i) such notice of hen is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retting of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the mann prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in apportance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refilling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required reliting period for such notice of lian.

Release Of Lien Or Sec. 6325. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such requistions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unantorceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and consplied by film a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of tis amount assessed, together with all interest in respect tnereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements during to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suretica the son, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103 Confidentiality and Disclosure at Neturns and Return information.

(x) Disclosure, of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes, -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such her may be disclosed to any person who furnishes catisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such hen or intends to obtain a right in such property
