## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

568(Y) (Fam

12-85

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person flable to pay any tax neglects or refuses o pay the same after demand, the arrount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lilen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

، Sec. 6322، Reriod Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lian imposed by section 6321 shalf arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount or assessed (or a judgment against the caxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienters, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

## (f) Place For Filling Notice: Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be desired to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its obvaical location; or

(8) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, at the residence of the taxp yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

Fur purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part easily shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal carcuitive office of the business is located, and the residence of a functive whose residence is without the United States shall be for much to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law re-arding the form or content of a notice of lian.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filled with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory lien

- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section.
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of filen is retiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of filen shall be treated as tiled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refuling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be alfective only.

(A) if -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiling of notice of hen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Rolease Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall laste a cartificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
