

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Coun

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

It any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shell be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the fier imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laces of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Oraditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's flanor, or judgment lien craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

in Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the fien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal preperty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdiviction), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is situated or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has a not by law designated one office which moets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

the property subject to the lieurs situated in the District of Columbia. If

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, wither tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp yer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or part term to shall be deemed to be the piace at which the principal stractive office of the business is focushed, and the residence of the deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Buch notice of a revealed notwithstanding any other provision of law regardue the form or content of a notice of lies.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of tien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Mator vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory flen

- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

- 9. Certain insurance contracts
- 10. Passpook loans

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refliing period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of hen refiled during the required retiling period shall be effective only.

(A) (I -

 (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a reflling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations leaved by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyer's residence. If a notice of such iten is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) **Richage Of Lieft.** — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

 Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Becretary and accrossed by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, which the time practibed by law (including any extens on of ruch (time), and that is in accordance with such requirenced, in find to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties incruon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding Iren - If a notice of Iren has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such Iren may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such Iren or intends to obtain a right in such property.
