

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cort.

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to 'pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date in specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the tiability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayor arising out of such liability) is estiafied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lease of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inserects, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment
Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall
not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security
interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice
thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has
been filled by the Secretary

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(i) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State to: the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(G) With Recorder Of Beeds Of The District Of Columbia in the effice of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia if the property subject to the lien is cituated in the District of Columbia (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lie $_{\rm to}$ - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shalf be deemed to be altuated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of reat property, at its obysical location; or

(B) Personal Property. In the case of personal property, which tangible or intangible, at the residence of the laxpeter at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partn (ahr), shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal execution office of the business is leached, and the residence of a lust ever whose residence is without the United States shall be deer set to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form. The Jum and cannent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice snrx by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regated to the form or content of a notice of lien.

(p) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

- (1) General Rule, Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as fried on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period
- (2) Place For Filling, A notice of iten refited during the required refiting period shall be effective only (A) if
 - (i) such natice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice at lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of rad property, the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of sen under supparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such iten is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is lecated.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the farm "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for each notice of ties.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any item imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the itability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or lise become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Band Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law including awtens in of ruch time), and that is in accordance with such requirements for the time, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties the son, as may be specified by such regulations.
