WHEREAS, the territory hereinafter described is not within the corporate limits of the Dolton Public Library District but is contiguous to the Dolton Public Library District, Cook County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Dolton is included entirely within the Dolton Public Library District; and

WHEREAS, the said territory was annexed by the Village of Dolton by official action on June 11, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the said territory is without local tax supported public library service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Dolton Public Library District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I: That the territory legally described as follows:

ALL THAT PART (INCLUDING STREETS AND ALLEYS) OF CALUMET TERRACE DELUXE SUBDIVISION (BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTHEAST $\frac{1}{4}$ OF THE NORTHEAST $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, LYING NORTH OF MICHIGAN CITY ROAD, AS PER PLAT THEREOF RECORDED MARCH 4, 1925 AS DOCUMENT #8 798 575) LYING WEST OF THE EAST LINE, EXTENDED NORTH AND SOUTH, OF THE PUBLIC ALLEY AS HERETOFORE DEDICATED IN BLOCK 1 IN THE AFORESAID CALUMET TERRACE DELUXE SUBDIVISION, ALL IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS;

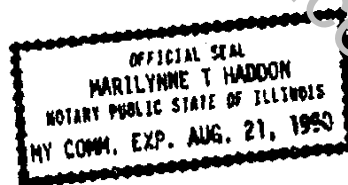
