Subject to the limits stated in Section 4(D) below, this rounded amount will be my new interest rate until the next Change Date.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the monthly pryment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal that I am expected to owe at the Change Date in full on the paturity date at my new interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this calculation will be the new incount of my monthly payment.

### (D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

To the extent permitted by applicable law, Lender may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to the loan assumption. Lender may also require the transferee to sign an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferee to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.

(the "Condominium Project"). If the owners association or other entity which acts for the Condominium Project (the "Owners Association") holds title to property for the benefit or use of its members or shareholders, the Property also includes Borrower's interest in the Owners Association and the uses, proceeds and benefits of Borrower's interest.

CONDOM'SIVM COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lendle further covenant and agree as follows:

- D. Condemnation. - (ii) any amendment to any provision of the Constituent Documents if the provision is for the express benefit of Lender:
  - (iii) termination of professional management and assumption of self-management of the Owners Association;
- (iv) any action which would have the effect of rendering the public liability insurance to erage maintained by the Owners Association unacceptable to Lender.
- F. Remedies. If Borrower does not pay condominium dues and assessments when due, then Lender may pay them. Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become additional debt of Borrower secured to the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.
