

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to gay the same after demand, the amount (including any intertional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, teaether with any costs that may accrue in addition therete) shall be a lien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien ed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so need (or a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such Hability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inprests, Mechanic's Llenors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6221 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until netice ereef which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been flied by the Secretary.

m Place For Filling Natice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subction (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(1) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental ivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office in the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. which the property subject to the lien is situated:

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the affice of the Recorder of Doods of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the ken is situated in the District of (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its hy nettend incestor: or

(a) Personal Property - in the case of personal property. wheth a tan nible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp, ver at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of partigraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the arthropal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer affice residence is without the United States shall be deemed to so in the Platrict of Columbia.

(8) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a, shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be falld notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the in in or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refling Of Notice. — For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of tien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be tracted as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reflling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of iten refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the men prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) mos. (3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years efter the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of Nan.

Release Of Lien Or Sec. 6325. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lion. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
