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WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of public alley described in the following ordinance; now, therefore,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. That all that part of the north-south 18.5 foot public alley lying east of the east line of Lots 27 to 31, both inclusive; lying west of the west line of Lot 32; lying south of a line drawn from the northeast corner of Lot 31 to the northwest corner of Lot 32; and lying north of the eastwardly extension of the south line of Lot 27, all in Block 28 in Subdivision of Blocks 9, 10, 24 to 27, 40 to 42, and the southwest part of 43 in Ogden's Addition to Chicago in Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian; said part of public alley herein vacated being further described as the north 125 feet of the north-south 18.5 foot public alley in the block bounded by W. Erie Street, W. Ohio Street, N. Racine Avenue and N. May Street as colored in red and indicated by the words "To Be Vacated" on the drawing hereto attached, which drawing for greater certainty is hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed inasmuch as the same is no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation.

SECTION 2. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, Helen M. Goddard and Hoppe Tire Company shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owner of the property abutting said part of public alley hereby vacated, the sum of Fourteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$14,000), which sum is in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits; and further, shall within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, deposit in the City Treasury of the City of Chicago a sum sufficient to defray the costs of removing paving and curb returns and constructing sidewalk and curb across the entrance to that part of the public alley hereby vacated, similar to the sidewalk and curb in W. Erie Street. The precise amount of the sum so deposited shall be ascertained by the Commissioner of Public Works after such investigation as is requisite.

SECTION 3. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the Helen M. Goddard and Hoppe Tire Company shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by the Superintendent of Maps.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

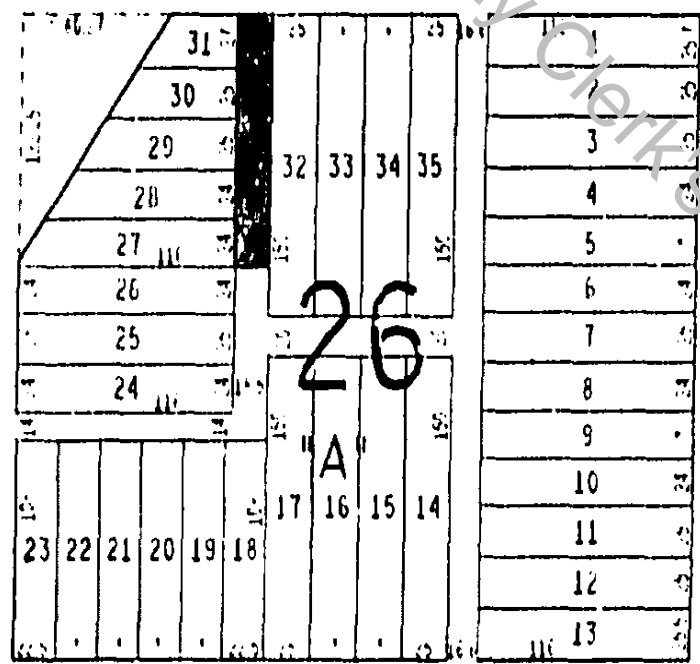
