If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under subparagraph (a) of the preceding paragraph shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee as Trustee for ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor for such items or, at the Mortgagee's option as Trustee, shall be refunded to the Mortgagor. It is expressly provided, however, (all other provisions of this mortgage to the contrary notwithstanding), that the Mortgagee shall not be required nor shall it have the right to pay, discharge, or remove any tax, assessment, or expense of any kind, or any amount so advanced as to exceed the ultimate maturity of the note first described above.

Upon the request of the Mortgagor to make such payment, modernization, maintenance, repair, or replacement of sums advanced by the Mortgagee for the alteration, modernization, maintenance, repair, or replacement of such premises, for taxes or assessments again, the same and for any other purpose authorized by the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness and shall be payable in equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the creditor and debtor. Falling to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after demand by the creditor.
