Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interes. additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layer of the Linded States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law the hen im posed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayer ansing out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Hen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, rechalicle fellor, or judgesent lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any infornal revenue tax not user than 30 days after the day on
