

Sec. 8321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interast, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, her with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) half be a lien in tover of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Uniose another date is apecifically fixed by law, the lies imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lance of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The pin imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any sections, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice there which meets the repulgaments of subsection (f) has been titled by the Secretary been filed by the Secretary.
