(BiPurchaser's, Holders Of Security Interesis, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment **Lies: Creditors.** — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be walld as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest pechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thersof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

Sec. Release Of Lien 6325. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lion. -- Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shell Issue a certificate of release of any Ijen Imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unerdorceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furrushed to the Secretary and accorded by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, annin the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirences, as such to terms, conditions, and form of the fond and sureties inertion, as may be specified by such regulations.
