

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Couls

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the tien imposed by section 621 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which mesta the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (s) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the item is situated; or

(8) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to live is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of

subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be desmed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpi yer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part east in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal exclusive office of the business is located, and the residence of ***Lay* ayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The Jurn and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice and we valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regardly the form or content of a notice of lies.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

(i) General Rule. — Unless notice of fien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shalf be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of lien reliled during the required refilling pariod shall be effective only.

(A) II •

(i) such notice of tien is retiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection. (f). (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiting or notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also tried in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required rafiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required rafiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legativ unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary essenced by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the mount assessed, together with all interest in respect towers, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of rich time), and that is in accordance with such requirement of laing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties therein, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Raturns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lies. - If a notice of tien has been tiled pursuant to section 8323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lies may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written syidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lies or intends to obtain a right in such property.
