ADDITIONAL CONVENANTS. CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE AND INCORPORATED THEREIN BY REFERENCE.

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for fien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when dife any indebiedness which may be secured by a lien of charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof (3d dipolarealies) exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagor or to holder of the contract; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises. (5) within with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Morigagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes and shall pay apecial taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall upon written request, furnish to Morigagee or to holders of the contract duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under profesh, fit the manner provided by statute, any fux or assessment which Mortgagors may desire, to enjoy test.
- which Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now and hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policles providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient efficient opatible cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the holders of the contract, under insurance policles payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policies and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In case of default therein. All moneys paid for any of these purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or included in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee of holders of the contract of the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and pay able without notice. Inaction of Mortgagee or holders of the contract shall never be considered as a waiver of any right according to them on account of right hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 5.
