

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cody

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tavor of the United States upon all property and rights to preperty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ilen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests: Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Coditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be 'paid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof Prijich meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been find by the Secretary.

m Flace For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice raterrad to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has -inot by taw designated one office which meets the requirements of subsarantabl (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

Columbia:

(2) Shor Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its proyecty, at its

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, another tampible or intengible, at the realdence of the taxpuyer at the time the notice of lien is fifed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or par, per ain shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal at active office of the business is located, and the residence of a without the United States shall be defined to he in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice start to valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regardles the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of flen is retited in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of flen shall be frested as filled on the data on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Piace For Filing. A notice of lien reflied during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(A) If -

 such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is emered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(8) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (i) is the State in which such residence is lecated.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period fer such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not fater than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become tegally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, arms the time prescribed by law (including any extension of a sch time), and that is in accordance with such requirements in a line to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suretice form on its may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Boturns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding (ien. - If a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written ovidence that has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
