MORTGAGE

This Indenture made this 17th day of October, 1985 between JOSEPH L. NOVAK, hereinafter referred to as "Mortgagor" and LEO NOVAK and GERTRUDE B. NOVAK hereinafter referred to as "Mortgagee", witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is justly indebted to the Mortgagee upon the installment note of even date herewith, in the principal sum of NINETEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS and EIGHTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$19,424.88) payable to the order of and delivered to the Mortgagee, in and by which note the Mortgagor promises to pay the said principal sum and interest at the rate and in installments as provided in said note, with a final payment of the balance due on the 19th day of October, 1995, and all of said principal and interest are made payable at such place as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgagee at 7101 West 63rd Street, Chicago, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagor to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of the mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagor to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY AND WARRANT unto the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the CITY OF CHICAGO, COUNTY OF COOK, AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily) and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing) screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings in and/or beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed on the premises by Mortgagor or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.



1. Mortgagor shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed, (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for hire not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof, (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by either or both on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagor; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.

2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagor duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest.

3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of Illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any tax thereon or imposing upon the Mortgagor the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or fees herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagor's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagor upon demand by the Mortgagor, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or contribute the Mortgagor thereto; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagor (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagor may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

4. As by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any taxes, due or becoming due, in respect of the amount of the sum hereby, prepared, the Mortgagor, covenant and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by law or such tax. The Mortgagor further covenant to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify the Mortgagor, and the Mortgagor's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.

5. At such time as the Mortgagor are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagor shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the regular payments) as may be provided in said note.

6. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of money sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagor, under insurance policies payable in case of loss or damage to Mortgagor, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagor, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

7. In case of default therein, Mortgagor may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act heretofore required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein mentioned and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagor to protect the mortgaged premises and the like heretofore, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law. Interest of Mortgagor shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to the Mortgagor on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagor.

8. The Mortgagor making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, rate, forfeiture, tax, fee or title or claim thereof.

9. Mortgagor shall pay such item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagor and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagor herein contained.

10. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagor shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included no additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagor for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, initials for documentary and expert evidence, demographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to amounts to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such documents of title, title searches, and examinations, title insurance policies, Turtens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagor may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become no much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon, at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law, when paid or incurred by Mortgagor in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagor shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after service of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.

11. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any principal to heirs, issue, wife, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

12. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a dwelling or not, and the Mortgagor may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or be used in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.

14. The Mortgagor shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

15. The Mortgagor shall periodically deposit with the Mortgagor such sums as the Mortgagor may reasonably require for payment of taxes and assessments on the premises. No such deposit shall bear any interest.

16. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the warranty be released, all persons or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to answer to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recovery against all such persons being expressly retained by the Mortgagor, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

17. Mortgagor shall release this mortgage and lien therefrom by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagor for the execution of such release.

18. This mortgage and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor and the word "Mortgagor" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagor" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the Mortgagor named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the note secured hereby.
