

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

H any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses & the same after demand, the amount (including any interst, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, tagether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property, whether real or personal, belonging to tush derson.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Parchaeer's, Holders Of Security Ins; Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Craffiors. — The Non Imposed by section 6821 shall Lien Ctachors. — The Non Imposed by section 1921 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security morset, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice hereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subotion (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other government subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated; and

(H) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated:

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to Hen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of eraeranh (A), pr

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deede of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Nen is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - Per purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the caxpe or at the time the notice of lien is filed.

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reitled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) **Place For Filing.** A notice of lien reflied during the required refliing period shall be effective only .

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the effice in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(iii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, \$0 days or more prior to the date of a refiling at notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the menner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the asset sement of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refitting period for such notice of lien.

- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be discissed to any person who furnishes extrafactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
