COVENANTS. Borrower covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the indebtedness incurred pursuant to the Agreement, together with any fees and charges provided in the Agreement.
- 2. Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Bank under the Agreement and paragraph 1 hereof shall be applied by Bank first in payment of amounts payable to Bank by Borrower under this Mortgage, then to interest, fees, and charges payable pursuant to the Agreement, then to the principal amounts outstanding under the Agreement.
- 3. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes assessments, and other charges, fines, and impositions attributable to the Property that may attain a priority over this Mortgage, leasehold payments or ground rents, if any, and all payments due under any mortgage disclosed by the title insurance policy insuring the Bank's interest in the Property (the "First Mortgage"), if any. Upon Bank's request, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Bank receipts evidencing payments of amounts due under this paragraph. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien that has priority over this Mortgage, except the lien of the First Mortgage, provided, that Borrower shall not be required to

- 15. Borrower's Copy, Borrower shall be furnished a conformed copy of the Agreement and of this Mortgage at the time of execution or after recordation hereof.
- 16. Transfer of the Property; Assumption. To the extent permitted by law, if all or any part of the Property or an interest therein, including without limitation any part of any beneficial interest in the Property in any trust holding title to the Property, is sold or transferred by Borrower without Bank's prior written consent, Bank may, at Bank's option, declare all the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable.
- 17. Revelving Credit Loan. This Mortgage is given to secure a revolving credit loan unless and until such loan is converted to an installment loan (as provided in the Agreement), and shall secure not only presently existing indebtedness under the Agreement but also future advances, whether such advances are obligatory or to be made at the option of the Bank, or otherwise, as are made in in 20 years from the date hereof, to the same extent as if such future advances were made on the date of the execution of this Mortgage, although there may be no advance made at the time of execution of this Mortgag; ar d although there may be no indebtedness secured hereby outstanding at the time any advance is made. The lien of this Mortgage shall be vatid as to all indebtedness secured hereby. including future advances, from the unic of its filing for record in the recorder's or registrar's office of the county in which the Property is located. The total amount of indebtedness secured horsey may increase or decrease from time to time, but the total unpaid principal balance of indebtedness secured hereby (including disbursements which the Brak may make under this Mortgage, the Agreement, or any other document with respect thereto) at any one time outstanding shall not exceed the Maximum Credit Amount, plus interest thereon, and any disbursements made for payment of taxes, special assessments, or insurance on the Property and interest on such disbursements (all such indebtedness being hereinaft ir r.fr. red to as the maximum amount secured hereby). This Mortgage shall be raid and have priority to the extent of the maximum amount secured hereby over all subsequent liens and encumbrances, including statutory lient, excepting solely taxes and assessments levied on the Property given priority by law.
- 18. Conversion to Installment Loan. Pursuant to the Agreement, the Bank may terminate the Agreement and convert the outstanding indebtedness incurred thereunder to an installment loan bearing interest at the rate set forth in the Agreement and payable in monthly installments

19. Acceleration; Remedies. Upon Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement of Borrower in this Mortgage, including the covenants to pay when due any sums secured by this Mortgage, or the occurrence of an Event of Default under the Agreement, which Events of Default are incorporated herein by this reference as though set forth in full herein, Bank, at Bank's option, may declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable without further demand, may terminate the availability of losses under the Agreement, and may foreclose this Mortgage by judicial proceeding. Bank shall be entitled to collect in such proceeding all expenses of foreclosure, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, and costs of documentary evidence, abstracts, and title reports.

All remedies provided in this Mortgage are distinct and cumulative to any other right or remedy under this Mortgage, the Agreement, or afforded by law or equity, and may be exercised concurrently, independently, or successively.

20. Assignment of Rents; Appointment of Receiver; Lender in Possession. As additional security hereunder, Borrower hereby assigns to Bank the rents of the Property, provided that Borrower shall, prior to acceleration under paragraph 19 hereof or abandonment of the Property, have the right to collect and retain such rents as they become due and payable.

Upon acceleration under paragraph 19 hersof or abandonment of the Property, and at any time prior to the expiration of any period of redemption following judicial sale, Bank, in person, by agent, or by judicially appointed receiver, shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. All rents collected by Bank or the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the costs of management of the Property and collection of rents including, but not limited to receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorney's fees, and then to the sums secured by this Mortgage. Bank and the receiver shall be liable to account only for those rents actually received.

4. Hazard Insurance. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower and approved by the Bank (which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld). All premiums on insurance policies shall be paid in a timely manner. All insurance policies and renewals thereof shall be in form acceptable to Bank and shall include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in form a captable to Bank. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Bank all renewal notices and all receipts for paid premiums. In the event of loss. Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Bank. Bank may make pro if o loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Bank and Borrovar cherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restora ion or repair of the Property damaged, provided such restoration or repair is economically feasible and the security of this Mortgage is not thereby impaired. If such restoration or repair is not economically feasible or if the security of this Mortgage would be impaired, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. Unless Bank and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any suc application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the payments due under the Agreement or change the amount of such payments. If under paragraph 19 hereof, the Property is acquired by Bank, all right, title, and interest of Borrower in and to any insurance policies and in and to the proceeds thereof resulting from damage to the Property prior to the sale or acquisition shall pass to Bank to the extent of the sums secured by this Mortgage immediately prior to such sale or acquisition.

- 5. Preservation and Maintenance of Property; Leaseholds; Condominiums; Planned Unit Developments. Borrower shall keep the Property in good repair and shall not commit waste or permit impairment or deterioration of the Property and shall comply with the provisions of any lease if this Mortgage is on a leasehold. If this Mortgage is on a unit in a condominium or a planned unit development. Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under the declaration or covenants creating or governing the condominium or planned unit development, the bylaws and regulations of the condominium or planned unit development, and constituent documents. If a condominium or planned unit development rider is executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Mortgage, the covenants and agreements of such rider shall be incorporated into and shall amend and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Mortgage as if the rider were a part hereof.
- 6. Protection of Bank's Security. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that materially affects Bank's interest in the Property, including, but not limited to any proceeding by or on behalf of a prior mortgagee, eminent domain, insolvency, code enforcement, or arrangements or proceedings involving a bankrupt or decedent, then Bank, at Bank's option, upon notice to Borrower, may make such appearances, disburse such sums and take such action as is necessary to protect Bank's interest, including, but not limited to, disbursement of reasonable attorney's fees and entry upon the Property to make repairs.

Any amounts disbursed by Bank pursuant to this paragraph 6, with interest thereon, shall become additional indebtedness of Borrower secured by this Mortgage. Unless Borrower and Bank agree to other terms of payment, such amounts shall be payable upon Bank's demand and shall

- 7. Inspection. Bank may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that Bank shall give Borrower notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefore related to Bank's interest in the Property.
- 8. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation. are heraby assigned and shall be paid to Bank. In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, that fraction of the proceeds of the award with a numerator equal to the total of Loans and other amounts secured immediately before the taking, and a denominator equal to the value of the Property immediately before the taking, shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, and the excess paid to the Borrower.

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if, after notice by Bank to Borrower that the condemnor has offered to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Bank within 30 days after the date such notice is mailed. Bank is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at Bank's option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mortgage.

Unless Bank and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any such application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the amount due under the Agreement or change the amount of such payments.

- 9. Borrower Not Released. No extension of the time for payment or modification of any other term of the Agreement or this Mortgage granted by Bank to any successor in interest of the Borrower shall operate to release, in any manner, the liability of the original Borrower and Borrower's successors in interest. Bank shall not be required to commence proceedings against such successor or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower and Portower's successors in interest.
- 10. For parance by Bank Not a Waiver. Any forbearance by Bank in exercising any right or remedy under the Agreement hereunder, or otherwise riferded by applicable law, shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of say such right or remedy. The procurement of insurance or the payment of taxes or other liens or charges by Bank shall not be a waiver of Bank's right to accelerate the maturity of the indebtodness secured by this Moriga, a
- 11. Successors and Assigns Eound; Joint and Several Liability; Captions. The covenants and agree nents herein contained shall bind, and the rights hereunder shall inure to the manactive successors and assigns of Bank and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 16 hereof. - 12. Legislation Affecting Bank's Rights. If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Agreement or this Mortgage unenforceable according to its terms, Bank, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage and may invoke any remedies permitted by paragraph 19.
- 13. Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Borrower provided for in this Mortgage shall be given by mailing such notice by certified mail addressed to Borrower at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower may designate by notice to Bank as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Bank shall be given by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Bank's address stated herein or to such other address as Bank may designate by notice to Borrower as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Mortgage shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Bank when given in the manner designated herein.
- 14. Governing Law; Severability. This Mortgage shall be governed by the laws of Illinois. In the event that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Note conflicts with applicable laws, such conflict shall

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RIDER TO EQUITY CREDIT LINE MORTGAGE

This Rider is made as of the 2nd day of January 1987, and is attached to and made a part of that certain Equity Credit Line Mortgage of even date herewith granted by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to The Northern Trust Company (the "Bank"),

- 23. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Section 19 of the Equity Credit Line Mortgage or in the Agreement, the Bank shall notify the Borrower at least 30 days prior to instituting any action leading to repossession or foreclosure (except in the case of the Borrower's abandonment the Property or other extreme circumstances).
- 24. If the Borrower has paid any precomputed finance charge, upon the Borrover's payment of the entire outstanding principal balance and termination of the Equity Credit Line, the Borrower shall be enticled to a refund of the unearned portion of such prepaid finance charge in an amount not less than the amount that would be calculated by the actuarial method, provided that the Borrower shall not be entitled to any refund of less than \$1.00. For the purposes of this Section 24, the term "actuarial method" shall mean the method of allocating payments made on a debt becasen the outstanding balance of the obligation and the precomputed finance charge pursuant to which a payment is applied first to the accrued precomputed finance charge and any remainder is subtracted from, or any deficiency is added to the outstopping balance of the obligation.
