## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cuts

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is epecifically fixed by law, the item imposed by section 6327 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall costinue until the liability for the amount so essessed (or a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as accept any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic planor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which medium requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Segretary.
