

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Coda

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging te such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unique another date to specifically fixed by law, the fien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so executed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

Sec. 6323. Valleity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

## (f) Place For Filing Notice; Form .-

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of fien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of tien shall be treated in filed on the data or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reffling period

Release Of Lien Or Sec. Discharge Of Property.
