## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any intert, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrus in addition thereit) shall be a lien in viewer of the United States upon all properly and rights to properly, whether real or personal, belonging te such parson.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien ed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so sed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of auch !lability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laces of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Putchaser's, Holders Of Security inprests, Stechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Jon Creditors. - The lien Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, medianic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice herael which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed Fighe Secretary.

## (1) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the project y subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the Blate (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, In which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(III) With Clark Of District Court - in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to firm is situated, whonever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subcaragraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Doods of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(21 Personal Property - in the case of parsonal preparty, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of iten is filed.

For purr use, of paragraph (2) (6), the residence of a corporation or particular chall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive affice of the business is located; and the residence of a true ayer whose residence is without the United

Status shall be decaded to the in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice refurred to in subsection (et chall be presented by the Secretary. Such notice at all to valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lies.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of flet is reflect in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required , refling period, such notice of flen shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reilling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required retiling period shall be effective only (A) If -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(iii) In the case of real property, the fact of retilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a ratiling at notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the ... Secretary resolved withtent information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayor's redicence, if a holide of such lies in also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(a) Required Reffling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refilling period" means. (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year parted ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such netice of tien.

Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. 6325. Sec.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any ilen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Band Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and 5. 32 ) ted by him a bend that is conditioned upon the payment of amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof with a the time prescribed by law (including any extension of evon time), and that is in accordance with such requirements, elf ing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond id sureties therein, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Neturns and Return Information.

int Discissure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes + :

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. - It a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes astisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
