

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the light special by section 6521 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so sessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or accomes unenforceable by reason

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(iii) Personal Property - in the case of personal properly, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental embdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a cartificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later then 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estimied or has

tecome legality unenforceable; or
