THAT WHEREAS the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the Mortgagee upon the installment note of even date herewith, in the principal sum of **Fifty One Thousand and 00/100** DOLLARS (\$51,000.00) payable to the order of and delivered to the Mortgagee, in and by which note the Mortgagors promise to pay the said principal sum and interest at the rate and in installments as provided in said note, with a final payment of the balance due on the **1st day of March 2004**, and all of said principal and interest are made payable at such place as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of the Mortgagee at **Geneva Crawford's 4916 S. Drexel Blvd. Chicago, Ill.** until further notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this mortgage, and the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY AND WARRANT unto the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situated, lying and being in the **CITY OF EVANSTON**, COUNTY OF **COOK** AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondary) and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, major beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by Mortgagor or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS HEREBY AGREED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE) OF THE  
MORTGAGE.

1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from nuisance's or other liens or claims for liens not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinances.

2. Mortgagors shall pay before any such liability attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may claim to contest.

3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of Illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon the mortgagor the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments, or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagors, or of enacting in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagors, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee, (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagors to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagors, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the note hereby secured, the Mortgagors covenants and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagors further covenant to hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.

5. At such time as the Mortgagors are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagors shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.

6. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and wind, or under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of money sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing, or to name or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance above to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten (10) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

7. In case of default therein, Mortgagors may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinafter required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, or otherwise settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises, or cancel any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, and any other monies advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereon, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to the Mortgagee on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.

8. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

9. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.

10. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and retained an additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and record evidence, stenographer's charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, and examination, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be held pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premise. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law, when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagee shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement or any suit for the foreclosure herein after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.

11. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness in addition to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legatees, representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

12. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, with or without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or as usual. In such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period, the Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interpreting same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.

14. The Mortgagors shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

15. The Mortgagors shall periodically deposit with the Mortgagee such sums as the Mortgagee may reasonably require for payment of taxes and assessments on the premises. No such deposit shall bear any interest.

16. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to answer to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

17. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and lien hereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the execution of such release.

18. This mortgage and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and shall work "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the Mortgagee named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the note secured hereby.

## Addendum

This is an addendum to an agreement between Emmett Simms and Geneva Crawford of 4916 S. Drexel Blvd., Chicago, Illinois known as the Sellers of 1920 Grey, Evanston, Illinois and Lelia Williams of 1920 Grey, Evanston, Illinois concerning the following documents:

- (a) Sales contract dated February 26, 1987
- (b) Deed dated May 2, 1986
- (c) Mortgage dated March 18, 1987
- (d) Installment Note dated March 18, 1987
- (e) Various and other sundry papers dated March 18, 1987 concerning 1920 Grey, Evanston, Illinois
- (f) Permanent Tax #10-13-108-022-0000

It is hereby agreed between the above parties as to the following:

### A. Real Estate Taxes:

There is to be no proration of Real Estate Taxes. The last Real Estate Tax Bill, due, February 1987 has been paid. Lelia Williams is to pay all future Real Estate Taxes. Real Estate Taxes are normally due in February and August of each year. In September and March of each year (within 30 days after payment), Mrs. Williams is to satisfy Mr. Emmett Simms and Mrs. Geneva Crawford of this payment by forwarding to them a copy of the paid Real Estate Tax Bill. Failure to pay taxes and send a copy is a breach of this agreement the Mortgage, Installment Note and cause for proper legal action.

### B. Insurance:

Mrs. Geneva Crawford has paid Chandler & Sons Insurance Agency the insurance on 1920 Grey, Evanston, Illinois until September 1987.

After September 1, 1987, Mrs. Lelia Williams will be responsible for and will pay the insurance premiums on the property located at 1920 Grey, Evanston, Illinois. Before the end of October of each year, Mrs. Williams shall present a copy of the yearly Insurance Policy and the paid premium to Emmett Simms and/or Geneva Crawford. Said Policy to carry a stipulation stating "Loss, first payable to Emmett Simms and Geneva Crawford as 1st Mortgage."

The Insurance amount per the Policy shall not be less than \$51,000.00.
