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Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to ney the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to lax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition theretol shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whather real or personal, belonging te such paraon.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unisss another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such (lability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Valldity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

ru Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Liep Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lianor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meats the requirements of subsection (f) had been flied by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filled -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is cituated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Beeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.i

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tax; eyer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

For nurners of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or patmer hip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located; and the residence of a pager whose residence is without the United States shall be di smed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the hotice referred to in subsiction (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice stan be valld notwithstanding any other provision of law recurring the form or content of a

(a) Refilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required celilled period, such notice of lien shall be treated as died on the date on which it is illed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of lien reflied during the required relating period shall be altective any -

(A) II -

(i) such notice of then is reflied in the affice in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

1. (ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In poy-case in which 80 days of more prior to the date [Girls resilute of notice of hen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lian is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reilling Period. — in the game of any notice of tien, the term "required reftling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tux, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years. after the close of the preceding required reflling period for such notice of iten."

6325. Sec. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 20 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or
(2) Bond Accepted • There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a hand that is conditioned upon the payment of ti a amount assessed, together with all interest in respect mereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements making to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suretle, through as may be specified by such regulations.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of putstanding lien. • If a notice of lion has been filed pursuant to section (323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lich may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such flen or intends to obtain a right in such property.
