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JUNIOR MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE made this $\frac{19^{4k}}{100}$ day of March, 1987, by

HARRIS TRUST AND SAVINGS BANK, not personally but solely as Trustee under Trust Agreement dated March 11, 1985 and known as Trust No. 43055

(herein, whether one or more, and if more than one jointly and severally, called the "Mortgagor") to

ATLANTIC PIONEER FINANCIAL CORPORATION, a Florida corporation whose address is Pioneer Center, P.O. Box 4608, Clearwater, Florida 33518

(herein, together with its successors and assigns, including each and every from time to time holder of the Note hereinafter referred to, called the "Mortgagee"), WITNESSETH:

THAT, WHEREAS Mortgagor has concurrently herewith executed and delivered an adjustable interest rate junior mortgage note bearing even date herewith (the "Note") in the principal sum of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$650,000.00) made payable to Mortgagee in and by which Note Mortgagor promises to pay the said principal sum and interest thereon at the rate and in installments as provided in the Note, with a final payment of the balance due on the lst day of May, 1927, if not sooner paid, unless extended in accordance with the terms of the Note not to exceed an additional six months, all of said principal and interest being payable at such place as the holder or holders of the Note (the "Holders") may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgagee, at the address above described.

NOW, THEREFORE, Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment of both principal and interest thereof, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Note and in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this mortgage, and to secure the performance of the covenants and

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agreements herein and in the Note contained, to be performed by Mortgagor, does by these presents MORTGAGE, GRANT, REMISE, RELEASE, ALIEN and CONVEY unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate and all of its estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the Village of Palatine, County of Cook, and State of Illinois, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof which, with the property hereinaitan described, is referred to as the "Premises,"

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, buildings, easements, fixtures, privileges, reservations, allowances, hereditaments and appartenances thereto pertaining or belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgager may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and including but not limited to all shades, awnings, venetian blinds, screens, screen doors, storm doors and windows, stoves and ranges, curtain fixtures, partitions, attached floor covering, now or hereafter therein or thereon and all fixtures, machines, machinery, apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air cooling, air conditioning, water, light, power, sanitation, sprinkler protection, waste removal, refriggration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), all other fixtures, machines, machinery, apparatus, equipment, furniture, furnishings, and articles used or useful in connection with the operation of said real estate now or hereafter located upon said Premises, it being understood that the enumeration of any specific articles of property shall in nowise result in or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically

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mentioned. All of the land, estate and property hereinabove described, real, personal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed or not (except where otherwise hereinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and mortgaged are intended so to be as a unit and are hereby understood, agreed and declared to form a part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate, and shall for the purposes of this mortgage be deemed to be real estate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby. As to any of the property aforesaid which (notwithstanding the aforesaid declaration and agreement) does not so form a part and parcel of the real estate, this mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgagor hereby grants to Mortgagee as Securad Party (as said term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), securing said indebtedness and obligations.

Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the Premises, that the same are unencumbered except for a mortgage dated March 29, 1985, in favor of Pioneer Savings Bank, F.S.B. as mortgagee recorded as document 27501487 in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, and that it has good right, full power and lawful authority to convey and mortgage the same, and that it will was forever defend said Premises and the quiet and peaceful possession of the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Premises unto the said Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and uses herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

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- 1. Payment of Indebtedness. The Mortgagor will duly and promptly pay each and every installment of the principal of and interest and premium, if any, on the Note, and all other indebtedness secured hereby, as the same become due, and will duly perform and observe all of the covenants, agreements and provisions herein or in the Note provided on the part of the Mortgagor to be performed and observed.
- Maintenance. Repair and Restoration of Improvements. Payment of Prior Liens, Etc. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restors or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep the Premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and frie from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the Premises on a parity with or superior to the lien hereof and comply with all regardements of all loan documents evidencing or securing such indebtedness, and upon request, exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings or any improvements now or at any time in the process of erection upon the Premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances, or restrictions of record with respect to the Premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material alterations in the Premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (g) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the Premises, without Mortgagee's written consent; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning variation or reclassification, without Mortgagee's written consent; (i) pay all operating costs of the Premises; and (j) provide, improve, grade, surface and thereafter maintain, clean, repair, police and adequately light parking

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areas within the Premises of sufficient size to accommodate not less than that number of standard size American made automobiles as may be required by local zoning authorities, codes or other laws, together with any sidewalks, aisles, streets, driveways and sidewalk cuts and sufficient paved areas for ingress, egress and right-of-way to and from the adjacent public throroughfares necessary or desirable for the use thereof.

3. Taxes. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the Premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder, Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest.

Mortgages may from time to time in writing appoint, and in the absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgages in Clearwater, Florida, commencing with the date the first payment of interest and/or principal and interest shall become due on the debt secured hereby, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the indebtedness secured by this mortgage is fully paid, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the last total annual taxes and assessments for the last ascertainable year (general and special) on said Premises (unless said taxes are based upon assessments which exclude the improvements or any part thereof now constructed, or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deposits shall be based upon Mortgages's reasonable estimate as to the amount of taxes and assessments to be levied and assessed). Mortgagor, concurrently with the disbursement

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of the loan, will also deposit with Mortgagee an amount, based upon the taxes and assessments so ascertainable or so estimated by Mortgagee, as the case may be, for taxes and assessments on said Premises, on the accrual basis, for the period from January 1 succeeding the year for which all taxes and assessments have been paid, to and including the date of the first deposit in this paragraph hereinabove mentioned. Such deposits are to be held without an allowance of interest and are to be used for the payment of taxes and assessments (general and special) on said Premises next due and payable when they become If the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes or assessmence (general and special) for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit such additional funds as may be accessary to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) for any year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. Provided, however, that Mortgagor shall not be required to make the deposits required hereunder, if and to the extent that Mortgagor shall have made equivalent deposits to the Mortgagee under any prior mortgage.

4. Insurance. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on the Premises insured in amounts equal to the full actual replacement value of the Premises, against loss or damage by fire, tornado, windstorm and extended coverage perils, vandalism and malicious mischief and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee, including, without limitation on the generality of the foregoing, war damage insurance whenever in the opinion of Mortgagee such protection is necessary and is available from an

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agency of the United States of America. Mortgagor shall also provide liability insurance with such limits for personal injury and death and property damage as Mortgagee may require and flood insurance if the Premises are in a flood area, all amounts required herein to be paid by the Mortgagor.

All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies and amounts satisfactory to Mortgagee, with mortgagee clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without ten (10) days' prior written notice to Mortgagee. Mortgager shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, together with evidence of payment of premiums thereon, to Mortgagee, and in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than thirty (30) days prior to their respective dates of expiration.

5. Mortgagee's Interest in and UFP of Deposits. In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this mortgage or in the Note, Mortgagee may at its option, without being required to do so, apply any moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to any provision of this mortgage, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, on any of Mortgagor's obligations herein or in the Note contained, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagor or to the then owner or owners of the Premises. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held to be irrevocably

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applied by the depositary for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, that neither Mortgages nor said depositary shall be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes and assessments or insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested said depositary in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of the particular taxes or assessments or the payment of the particular insurance premiums as the case may be for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes and assessments or insurance premiums. Mortgagor shall maintain or cause to be maintained with Mortgagee a custodian account for "lease security deposits' as more fully described in Paragraph 4 of that certain Loan Commitment dated February 15, 1985, between Mortgagor and Pioneer Savings Bank, F.S.B. Provided, however, that such custodian account need not be maintained hereunder during any period when such account is maintained under the prior mortgage.

6. Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance. The Mortgagor will give Mortgagee prompt notice of any damage to or destruction of the Premises, and in case of loss, Mortgagee (or after entry of decree or foraclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (a) to settle and adjust any claim under those insurance policies maintained by Mortgagor pursuant to Section 4 hereof without consent of Mortgagor, or (b) to allow Mortgagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case, Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. If (a) Mortgagor is obligated to restore or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or

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improvements under the terms of any lease or leases which are or may be prior to the lien of this mortgage, and (b) such damage or destruction does not result in cancellation or termination of such lease, and (c) the insurers do not deny liability as to the insureds, such proceeds, after deducting therefrom any expenses incurred in the collection thereof, shall be used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements on said premises. In all other cases, such insurance proceeds may, at the option of Mortgagee, either be applied in payment or reduction of the indebtedness secured haraby, whether due or not, or be held by Mortgages and used to reliburse Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoration of buildings or improvements on said Premises. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. the event Mortgagee elects to reimburse Mortgagor out of insurance proceeds, such proceeds shall be made available, from time to time, upon Mortgagee's being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such architect's certificates, waivers of lien, convertors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. If the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagee shall also be furnished with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the final

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completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of said proceeds remaining in the hands of Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens. No interest shall be allowed to Mortgager on account of any proceeds of insurance or other funds in the hands of Mortgagee.

In case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, it not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings of improvements, shall be applied in payment or reduction of the indeptedness secured hereby or in payment or reduction of the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if it shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In the case of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the court in its decree may provide that the mortgagee's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said decree creditor; and any such foreclosure decree may further provide that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each succesive redemptor may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be cancelled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redemptor. In the event of foreclosure sale, Mortgagee is heraby authorized, without the consent of Mortgagor, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or

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to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

- 7. Stamp Tax. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note, or recording of this mortgage, Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgagor further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify Mortgagee, its successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the Note, or recording of this mortgage.
- 8. Prepayment. At such time as Mortgagor is not in default either under the terms of the Note or under the terms of this Mortgage, Mortgagor shall have the privilege of prepaying all, but not less than all, of the principal balance of the Note (in addition to the required payments), apon giving the Mortgagee sixty (60) days' notice in writing of intention to prepay, and upon paying Mortgagee in consideration of such privilege an amount equal to a percentage of the principal as follows: (a) a sum equal to three percent (3%) of the then principal balance will be paid by Mortgagor on principal prepaid during the first two (2) years of the permanent period of the loan; (b) a sum equal to two percent (2%) of the then principal balance will be paid by Mortgagor on principal prepaid during the next five (5) years of the loan; and (c) a sum equal to one percent (1%) of the then principal balance will be paid by Mortgagor on principal prepaid during the remaining three (3) years of the loan. Provided, however, that if the building on the Premises encumbered by this mortgage is damaged or destroyed by fire or other casualty and Mortgagee applies the sums of money payable

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
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under the insurance policy or policies insuring the building on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, there shall be no prepayment penalty due with respect to any sums so applied.

- Effect of Extensions of Time, Amendments on Junior Liens and Others. If the payment of the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security granted to secure such indebtedness be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in the Premises, shall be deemed to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse acainst all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release. Any person, dirm or corporation taking a junior mortgage or other lien upon the Premises or any interest therein, shall take the said lier subject to the rights of the Mortgagee to amend, modify and surplement this mortgage, or the Note and to extend the maturity of the lebt secured hereby, in each and every case without obtaining the consent of the holder of such junior lien and without the lien of this mortgage losing its priority over the rights of any such junior lien.
- 10. Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation. In the event of the enactment after the date hereof of any law of the state in which the Premises are located deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt



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secured hereby or the Holders, then, and in any such event, Mortgagor, upon demand by Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

11. Mortgage Performance of Mortgagor's Obligation. case of default herein or therein, Mortgages may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein or in any loan documents evidencing or securing the indebtedness secured hereby or any indebtedness secured by a prior encumbrance, required of Mortgagor, in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payment; of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and if this is a leasehold mortgage, make payments of any rents due or to become due or perform any act under any underlying lease, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sals or forfeiture affecting the Premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the Premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the post maturity rate. Inaction of

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not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within ten (10) days; or (d) Mortgagor or any Guarantor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all of its property or the major part thereof; or (e) Mortgagor shall be in dafault under the terms of any note or mortgage or trust deed secured by or securing an interest in the Premises or shall fail to perform or observe any term, covenant, or condition on its part to be rerformed or observed under any agreement or instrument relating to any such note, mortgage or trust deed, when required to be parformed or observed, if the effect of such failure to perform or observe is to accelerate, or to permit the acceleration of, after the civing of notice or passage of time, or both, the maturity of such indebtedness, whether or not such failure to perform or observe shall be waived by the holder of such indebtedness, or any such indebtedness shall be declared to be due and payable, or required to be pripaid (other than by a regularly scheduled required prepayment), prior to the stated maturity thereof; or (f) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the coverants, agreements or conditions hereinbefore or hereinafter scatained, required to be kept or performed or observed by Mortgagor or any Guarantor and the same shall continue for fourteen (14) days; or (g) if the Premises shall be abandoned, then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once at the option of Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued interest thereon, without notice to Mortgagor.

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Foreclosure, Expense of Litigation. When the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof or enforce any other remedy of Mortgagee under this mortgage or the Note, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale or other judgment or decree all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fee, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Tourens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title and value as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true conditions of the ticle to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the lien of this mortgage, including the fees of any ettorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this mortgage, the Note or the Premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the post maturity rate and shall be secured by this mortgage.

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It is agreed that if default be made in the payment of any part of the secured indebtedness, Mortgagee shall have the right to proceed with foreclosure proceeding in the satisfaction of said default as if under a full foreclosure, and without declaring the entire secured indebtedness due, and provided that if foreclosure sale is made because of default of a part of the secured indebtedness, such sale may be made subject to the unmatriced part of the secured indebtedness; and it is agreed that such sale, if so made, shall not in any manner affect the unmatured part of the secured indebtedness, but as to such unmatured part this mortgage shall remain in full force and effect as if no foreclosure sale had been made under the provisions of this section. And it is further agreed that several foreclosure sairs may be made hereunder without exhausting the right of foreclosure sale for any unmatured part of the secured indebtedness, it being the purpose to provide for a foreclosure sale of the secured indebtedness for any matured portion of the secured indebtedness without exhausting the power to foreclose and to sell the Premises for any other of the secured indebtedness whether matured at the time or subsequently maturing.

15. Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sile The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the Premises shall had distributed and applied in the following order of prioricy: first, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding Section hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, to interest

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remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, to the principal remaining unpaid on the Note; and lastly, any overplus to Mortgagor, its succesors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

Appointment of Receiver. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and Mortgages hereunder or any Holders may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power: (a) to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits; (b) to extend or modify any then existing leases and to make new leases, which extensions, modifications and new leases may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lessees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the indebtedness hereunder and beyond the date of the issuance of a deed or deeds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons whose interests in the Premises are subject to the lien hereof and upon the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the mortgage

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indebtedness, satisfaction of any foreclosure decree, or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any purchaser; and (c) all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of:

(a) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (i) if this is a leasehold mortgage, all rents due or which may become due under the underlying lease; and (c) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

Assignment of Rents and Leases. To further secure the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagor hereby sells, assigns and transfer unto Mortgagee all the renta, issues and profits now due and which may hereafter become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or occupancy of the Piwhises or any part thereof, which may have been heretofore or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by Morigagee under the powers herein granted, it being the intention nereby to establish an absolute transfer and assignment of all such leases and agreements, and all the avails thereunder, to Mortgages. Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in possession of any portion of the Premises for more than one installment in advance and that the payment of none of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said Premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, discounted or otherwise discharged or compromised by Mortgagor. Mortgagor waives any rights of set off against any person in possession of any portion of the Premises. Mortgagor agrees that it will not assign any of the rents or profits of the Premises, except to a purchaser or grantes of the Premises.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the Premises by Mortgagee pursuant to Section 19 hereof. In the exercise of the powers herein granted Mortgagee, no liability shall be asserted or enforced against Mortgagee, all such liability being expressly waived and released by Mortgagor.

- 25. Waiver of Defense. No action for the enforcement of the lien of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note.
- 26. Waiver of Statutory Rights. Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, redemption, stay, extension, or exemption 15.03, or any so-called "moratorium laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of this mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. Mortgagor, for itself and all who may claim through or under it, waives any and all right to have the property and estates comprising the Premises marshalled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having jurisdiction

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to foreclose such lien may order the Premises sold as an entirety. - 36. Execution of Separate Security Agreement, Financing Statements, etc. Mcrtgagor, and all Guarantors, upon request by Mortgagee from time to time, shall execute, acknowledge and deliver to Mortgagee such Security Agreements, Financing Statements and other similar security instruments, in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, covering all property of any kind whatsoever owned by Mortgagor which in the sole opinion of Mortgagee is essential to the operation of the mortgaged Premises and which constitutes goods within the meaning of the Uniform Commercial Code or concerning which there may be any doubt as to whether the title to same has been conveyed by, or security interest perfected by, this Mortgage under the laws of the state in which the Premises are located, and will further execute, acknowledge and deliver any financing statement, affidavit, continuation statement or certificate or other document as Mortgagee may request in order to perfect, preserve,
