

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cods

Sec. 6321, Lier For Taxes.

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after deriand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property; whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is tipicifically fixed by law, the fien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of labor of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

CETTAIN PERSUITS.

(a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanists Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. The lien imposed by section 621 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liently or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## (1) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filled -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in

which the property subject to the lien is situated; and (ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property...whether tangible or intangible in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to firm is situated, whenever the State has sot by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Peeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Goods of the District of Columbia; if : the property subject to the tien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(8) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whither tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpa, or at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or party trah p shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive effice of the business is secuted, and the residence of a tarraver whose residence is without the United States shall be deer and to be in the District of Columbia.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section

6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of raisease of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
