

Experpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accous in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether read or personal, belonging to such person.

Buc. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security In-Breets, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Represt, mechanic's lienor, or judgment fien creditor until notice rect which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has tion filed by the Secretary.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - Por purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -(A) Real Property - in the case of real preperty, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the way yer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection h) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regurding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is rethed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such natice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of him ratifed during the required refiting period shall be effective only (A) if -

- (i) such notice at tien is ratifed in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

Release Of Lien Or Sec. **6325**. Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a cartificate of release of any lies imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (1) Liability Batisfied or Unenforceable The Socratary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estisted or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Band Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect L'et of, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requires vents r Jaking to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suration the comman may be specified by such regulations.
