  1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly ripar estore of retaint by building a impute over show or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other hers or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a hen or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) compiles within a transpable time any building or building o complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises: (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use chereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except required by law or municipal ordinance
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, bightning and windstorm under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactors to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 4. In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act beteinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, it any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax fien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or context any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the fien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest theron at the rate agreed upon in the note. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right account to the Mortgagees on account of the protection of the Mortgagees. Mortgagee on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 5. The Mortgagee moking any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validay of any tax, assessment, sale, forter are tax hen or title or claim therof
- 6 Mortgagors shall pay act) item of indebtedness betein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee and o dout notice to Mortgagors, all impaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage o doe contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest of the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
- 7. If the Mortgagors sell or transfer all or part of the premises or any rights in the premises, any person to whom the Mortgagors sell or transfer the Premises may take over all of the Mortgagors' rights and obligations under this Mortgage (known as an "assumption of the Mortgage") if certain conditions are met. Those or all ones are
  - (A.) Mortgagors give Mortgagee notice of sale or mansfer;
  - (B.) Mortgagee agrees that the person qualifies indecits then usual credit criteria;
  - (C.) The person agrees to pay interest on the arrow't owed to Mortgagee under the note and under this Mortgage at whatever rate Mortgagee requires: and FOR MINING
  - (D.1) The person signs an assumption agreement that is were table to Mortgagee an that obligates the person to keep all of the promises and agreements made in the note and in this Mortgage
- If the Mortgagors sell or transfer the premises and the conditions (A.B. C. and D. of this section are not satisfied. Mortgagee may require infinediate payment in full of the note, foreclose the Mortgage, and seek any biner remedy of lowed by the law. However, Mortgagee will not have the right to require immediate payment in full or any other legal remedy as a result of certain transfers. Those transfers are.
  - (i) the creation of hens or other claims against the premises that are mirrior to this Mortgage, such as other mortgages, materialman's liens,
  - (ii) a transfer of rights in household appliances, to a person who provides the Acrigagors with the money to buy these appliances, in order to protect that person against possible lusses;
  - (iii) a tranter of the premises to surviving co-owners, following the death of a co-owner, when the transfer is automatic according to law, and
  - (iv) leasing the premises for a term of three (3) years or less, as long as the lease does not include an option to buy
- 8. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration of the live with the forest in any suit to foreclose the lieu hereof. There shall be allowed and included as a difficient indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fee, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be stimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, and examinations, title insurance policies. Fortens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or the vidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and in rediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate agreed upon in the note, when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate interest thereon at the rate agreed upon in the note, when paid or incurred by Morigages in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Morigages shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by causin of this morigage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure betool stor, accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced: or (c) preparations for the defense of any actual or threatened sur or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof.
- 9. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priving. First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mertioned in the preceding paragraph hereof, second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 10. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgaggers at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgager may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the tents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of tedemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagots, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be emitted to collect such tents, issues and profits, and all other nowers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the motochon reaconplion, whereign there ac reaconplion or not, as well as during any further times which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the projection, would be emitted to collect such tents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the projection, possession; control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of. (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decive foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency
- 1) The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and to make repairs to the premises as in its discretion it may exem necessary for the proper preservation thereof. Access thereto shall be permitted for those purposes.
- 12. If the payment of said indebtedness of any part thereof he extended of varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter hable dieretor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their hability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release
- Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and playment of a reasonable fee to Mottgagee for the execution of such religious.
- This mortgage and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Startgagots, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all just persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assons of the Mortgagee named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the note secured hereby
