### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The default of defendant Laminite having been entered, judgment is entered in favor of Westinghouse Electric Corporation ("Westinghouse") and against Laminite on Counts I, III and IV of the Complaint in the amount of \$21,582.77 plus prejudgment interest of \$134.89.

2. The default of defendant Laminite having been entered, judgment is entered in favor of Westinghouse and against Laminite on Count II of the Complaint in the amount of \$284,459.66 plus prejudgment interest of \$1,777.87. The

guaranty upon which Count II is based provides for payment of all legal costs and expenses incurred in connection with the enforcement of the guaranty. The total amount of attorneys fees incurred by Westinghouse in enforcement of the guaranty in connection with this lawsuit and the bankruptcy of Laminite Plastics, Inc. is \$5,380.25, and judgment is now entered in favor of Westinghouse and against Laminite in that additional amount.
