Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuse to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interfect, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preperty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

tal Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lian imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid at against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, michanic's lianor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof writch meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to an subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Reaf Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county or other governments) subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the fien is situated;

(B) With Clork Of District Court - to the office of the clork of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparaorabh (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds of the District Of Columbia of the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia of the property subject to the lien is situated in the Program of Columbia.

(f) Bitus Of Property Bubject To Lien - Por purposes of paragraphs (t) and (d), property shall be deemed to be situated (A) Real Property - In the case of itsel property, at its obvisical location, or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tengible or intangible, at the residence of the tall payer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (?) (B), the residence of a corporation or purine ship shall be deemed to be the place at which the principus usefully entire of the business is located, and the residence of a function whose residence is without the United States shall but semed to be in the District of Columbia.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of flon is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of flon shall be treated at filed on the date of which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (!)) after the expiration of such refiling period
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of tien reflied during the required refilling period shall be effective only (A) if

such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(3) Required Reilling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such holios of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and occepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect interent, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension c such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements electing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelics the applications.
