WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of public alleys described in the following ordinance; now, therefore,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. That all that part of the northwesterly-southeasterly 10-foot public alley lying southwesterly of the southwesterly line of Lots 8, 9 and 10 in

Resubdivision of the southeast 20 feet of Sub Lot 2 and Sub Lot 3 to 28 inclusive in Subdivision of Lots 56, 58, 60 and 62 and private alley southeast and adjoining above Lots, in Butterfield's Addition to Chicago, the W. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 and the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 4, Township 39 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the City of Chicago, after due deliberation and consideration, has determined that the public interest requires that the City of Chicago should acquire the property described in the following description, to-wit:

That the property described in the following description is situated in the City of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1, East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Township 36 North, Range 11 East, County Cook, Illinois, containing 1.25 acres, more or less, as shown on the plat of said section filed for record in Cook County, Illinois, on the 10th day of August, 1908, and on the 10th day of August, 1909.

And whereas, the Board of Supervisors of the City of Chicago, after due deliberation and consideration, has determined that the public interest requires that the City of Chicago should acquire the property described in the following description, to-wit:

Subdivision of Lots 52 and 54 in Butterfield's Addition to Chicago in the W. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 and the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 4, Township 39 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian;

all that part of the northeasterly-southwesterly 16-foot public alley lying southeasterly of the southeasterly line of Lots 11, 12, 13 and 14 in Resubdivision of the southeast 20 feet of Sub Lot 2 etc... aforementioned; lying northwesterly of the northwesterly line of Lots 1 and 2 in Subdivision of Lots 52 and 54 aforementioned; lying southwestwardly of the southeastwardly extension of the northeasterly line of Lot 11 in Resubdivision of the southeast 20 feet of Sub Lot 2 etc... aforementioned; and lying northeasterly of a line drawn northwesterly from and at right angle to the northwesterly line of Lot 2 in Subdivision of Lots 52 and 54 aforementioned at a point in the northwesterly line of Lot 2 which is 34 feet 4 and 1/2 inches northeasterly of the southwestwardly corner of Lot 2 (as measured on the northwesterly line of Lot 2); said part of public alleys herein vacated being further described as the southeasterly 89.12 feet of the northwesterly-southeasterly 10-foot public alley together with the northeasterly 97.03 feet of the northeasterly-southwesterly 16-foot public alley in the block bounded by N. Clybourn Avenue, N. Larrabee Street, W. Scott Street, and N. Cleveland Avenue as colored in red and indicated by the words "To Be Vacated" on the drawing hereto attached, which drawing for greater certainty, is hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby vacated and closed, inasmuch as the same are no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation.

SECTION 2. The vacations herein provided for are made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, Near North Health Service Corporation shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the corner of the property abutting said part of public alleys hereby vacated, the sum of Eight Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00), which sum in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits.

SECTION 3. The vacations herein provided for are made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the Near North Health Service Corporation shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by the Superintendent of Maps.
