- (ii) any amendment to any provision of the Constituent Documents if the president is for the express benefit of Lender;
 - (iii) termination of professional management and assumption of self-management of the Owners Association;
- or

 (iv) any action which would have the effect of rendering the public hability insurance, or erage maintained by
 the Owners Association unacceptable to Lender.
- F. Remedies. If Borrower does not pay condominium dues and assessments when due, then Leader may pay them Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest to im the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.
