

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien favor of the United States upon all property and tights to property, whatter real or personal, belonging to such person.

## Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless shother data is specifically fixed by law? the fish imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such (lability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against

Certain Persons.

G Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 5321 shall not be valid as equinst any purchaser, holder of a security impress, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thirds which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been also by the Secretary.

## in Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision); as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whichever the State has not by lew designated one office which meals the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the flen is situated in the District of Columbia,  $\frac{1}{2} C = \frac{1}{2} \frac{1}{12} \frac{1}{$ 

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated - (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

in Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of flen is filed.

For purrouse of paragraph (2) (11), the residence of a borporation or parmously, shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is facated, and the residence of a full gyer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

- (3) Form - The lorn and content of the notice referred to in subsect of shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be residentificated by the start provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lian.

(g) Refilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of then is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required' refilling period, such notice of then shall be treated as thed on the date prowhich it is titled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of lien sessed during the required satisfing period chall be affective only.

(A) If

(i) such notice of lian is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lian was filed, and

(III) in the case of real amounty, the fact of resisting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

The Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxwayer's recidence, if a notice of such lian is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 3 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of byears after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of titles.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any fien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and conted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amortil assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law (including amorting time), and that is in accordance with such requirements (etc...) to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies there is may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(s) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes:

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. - If a notice of then has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lieu may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lieu or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
