

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty logether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in lawer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, emetter real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the him imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laose of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority

- Against Certain Persons. (a) Pricingly Voltage Dr Security Interests, Mechanic's Living Man Judgment Lien Creditors.—The tien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment fron creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.
- (b) Pretaction For Cortain Interests Even Though Natice Filed. —Even though notice of a lien implied by sec-tion 5321 has been filed, such lien shalf not be valid.—
- (1) Place For Filing Notice: Form.— (1) Place For Filing.—The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed -
- (A) Under State Laws
- (i) Real Property.—In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other jouvernmental subdivision) (as delignated by the lawger supplicate in which the property subject to the fien is attuated; and
- (ii) Personal Property. -- in the case of personal proper ty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county; or other governmental subdivision). as designated by the laws of such State, in which the proparty subject to the lien is situated; or

iB) With Clerk Of District Court. In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial court of the first in which the property subject to the lien is stated which the State has not by the whole nated one office which meets the court sense of subparagraph (A), or

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Libra.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall assue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenterceable —The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted -There is turnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a lond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount aspessed, together with all in erest infrespect thereof, within the time prescribed by taw functions any extension of such time), and that is in accor-dance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and it miss the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
