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IMPORTANT! FOR THE PROTECTION OF BOTH THE BORROWER AND LENDER, THE INSTALMENT NOTE SECURED BY THIS TRUST DEED SHOULD BE IDENTIFIED BY THIS TRUSTEE BEFORE THE TRUST DEED IS FILED FOR RECORD.

13. Trustee shall retain this trust deed and the loan thereunder until payment in full of all indebtedness secured by property or instruments upon presentation of satisfactory evidence to verify the existence of such indebtedness.

14. Trustee may accept any note which bears an undifferentiated number purporting to be the note and which purports to be executed by the person designated as the maker of the note and which contains the name of the original trustee and the date of execution of the original trustee and 11 has never placed it in depositary hands.

15. 16. Beneficiary retaining this trust deed, trustee of successor shall receive for its services a fee to be determined by the trustee in accordance with the terms of this trust deed. 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12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence of conditions of the premises, or to incur a liability in case of loss of title due to the negligence of the lessee or his agent.

11. Trustees or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
