On or about June 10, 1987, the Village of Dixmoor filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County a suit to abate the nuisance on the above described real estate, being case number 87 M6-60030, and thereafter, on the 17th day of August, 1987, the Honorable Loretta C. Douglas, one of the Judges of the Circuit Court of Cook County, did enter a Decree authorizing and directing the Claimant herein to domolish the building and clean up the premises situated upon the above described real estate. Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes. Section 11-31-1, as amended, authorizes reimbursement for costs spore in the demolition of said buildings, and thereafter the Village of Dixmoor did secure the demolition of said structures and the clean-up of said premises on or about the 14th day of September, 1988, and the Village of Dixmoor, in securing the demolition of said building, did cause to be furnished labor and materials pursuant to a contract.
