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

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cour

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ilen Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laose of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inreets, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. The fish imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's ligior, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n Place For Billing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place Folk-liling - The notice referred to in subsection (s) shall be find-

(A) Under State

Under State Laws
(I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental) subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the iten is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Hen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp: yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For proces of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part ers! Ip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a lar lever whose residence is without the United States shall be ust med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The .orm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shart a valid notwithstanding any other provision of law recard up the form or content of a notice of flen.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this saction -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of itenils reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilting period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such retiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only (A) If -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of tien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

subsection (f) (4), and (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a raffling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the mann prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpays 's residence, if a net of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reffling Period. — in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien:

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of reisase of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the flability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accoled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof amin the time prescribed by law (including any extens on of such time), and that is in accordance with such requiremental rusting to terms, conditions, and form of the Sond and sureties the oun, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
