

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable pehalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien flavor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal belonging to such barson.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lian imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is mr." and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessible (or a judgment against the tapayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Ptirchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be velige as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, rigidiantic's lienor, or judgment from creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Fliing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - Tile notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subsect to the lien is situated, and

(iid Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is altitated.

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the crerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to tren is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of indicators of IA. or

C. With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia of the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of puragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be attuated (A). (p) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of lients ratiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notics of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of tien retiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only.

(A) if-

(i) such notice of lien is refuled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(8) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filled in excerdance with superaction (f) in the State in which such residence to technici.

(3) Required Retiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required retiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required retiting period for such notice of these.

to Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien - If a notice of lien has peen filled pursuant to section 6323(f) the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
