

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or retuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, tegether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto shall be a tion if favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, helder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## in Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

Ally Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the affice of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Jien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lion - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be attuated -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpi yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For our points of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partiership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal various we office of the business is lecated, and the residence of a fundament whose residence is without the United States shall be the ned to be in the Destrict of Columbia.

(3) Form . The same and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be precribed by the Secretary. Such notice the valid networkscaning any other provision of law regurdly the form or content of a notice of lies.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filled with respect to:

- (p) Refilling O1 Notice. for purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of ten is retiled in the manner prescribes in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of iten shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refling period
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only.

- (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was fried, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is emfered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (iii) and

(B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a rafiling of notice of ben under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manny prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyor's recidence. If a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such recidence is tecated.

(3) Required Refling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the pne-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Liers. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenterpashs The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, tegether with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenterpashie; or
- (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accreted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of his amount assessed, topother with all interest in respect thereof, armin the time prescribed by low (including ancients in of ruch time), and that is in accordance with such requirements in after the time, and there of the time and suretice one so, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disciosure of Returns and Return information.

- (t) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —
- (2) Discipsure of amount of outstanding lien If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section (\$323(f) the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be discissed to any person who furnishes assisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
