

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Co/A

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand the amount (including any interast, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty her with any couls that may accive in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether reat or personal belonging se such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lief imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so accessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapes of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(8) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craftors. — The ten imposes by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security imprest impleanic's lienor, or sudement lien creditor until notice thereof soligit meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
