

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cods

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person flable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, logather with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the lien Imposed by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall conjune until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such fiability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of Japan of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against: Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Heal Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated -(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, win thei tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For pursuant of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or pariner hin shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal execulty office of the business is located, and the residence or a furgover whose residence is without the United

States shall be or amed to be in the District of Columbia. (3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to in subscrition (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice ritall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law re-coing the form or content of a notice of tion.

- (a) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such retiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(A) If -

(i) such notice of lish is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (I) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 50 days or more prior to the date of a retiling of notice of hen under supparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(1) Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of ilen, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the lax, and (B) the one-year period anding with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of fiers.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Spoject to such requistions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with suspect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the flability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and (curpled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of th) amount assessed, together with all interact in respect theren, within the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements refoling to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties therein, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property
