JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

On October 3, 1984, Petitioner, SANDRA L. SNOOK, by J. WILLIAM STEFAN, her attorney, proceeded to trial and it appearing to the Court that Respondent, DAVID D. SNOOK, had due notice thereby by personal service, according to the Statutes in effect, that the Resi pondent was in default, and, the Petition herein filed was taken as CD confessed by the said Respondent, the Court being satisfied that all, proper means have been taken to notify the Respondent of the pendency of this suit.

The Court having heard the testimony of Petitioner taken in open Court in support of said Petition, (a transcript of which evidence of the Petitioner having been duly signed, certified and sealed, is filed herein and made a part hereof); and the Court being fully advised in the premises; DOES FIND:

- That the Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter hereof.
- That the Petitioner is now, and was at the time this action was commenced, domiciled in the State of Illinois, and that said domicile has been maintained for 90 days next preceeding the making of these findings.
- That the parties were lawfully married on June 8, 1974 at Western Springs, Illinois and the marriage was registered in Cook County, Illinois.
- That one child was born to the parties as a result of this marriage:

JENNIFER J. SNOOK - born December 29, 1977 8401551234

The child resides with the Petitioner and the Petitioner is not now pregnant. That the Petitioner is a fit and proper party to have the permanent care, custody and education of the minor child.

- 5. That the Petitioner is 34 years of age, presently residing at 120 Boardwalk, Elk Grove Village, Illinois.
- 6. That the Respondent is 41 years of age, and whose present residence is unknown.
- 7. That during all times mentioned herein, Petitioner has conducted herself as a good, true, loving and affectionate wife.
- 8. That Petitioner by competent evidence, established that without cause or provocation by the Petitioner, the Respondent has been guilty of extreme and repeated mental cruelty.
- 9. That Petitioner is entitled to the following items of marital property which shall be her own separate property:
 - a. Sole and exclusive ownership of the condominium unit located at 120 Boardwalk, Elk Grove Village, Illinois, legally described as follows:

Unit 120-5 in Boardwalk Condominium as delinated on survey of lots or parts thereof in Boardwalk Subdivision of Part of the North 15 acres of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 41 North, Range 11, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, according to the plat thereof recorded as Document No. 21840416 in Cook County, Illinois, which survey is attached as Exhibit A to Declaration of Condominium Ownersiip made by National Bank of Austin, as Trustee under Trust No. 5160 recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, as Document No. 22-633-866, together with a percentage of the Common Elements Appurtenant to said unitas set forth in said Declaration, as amended from time to time. Index # 08-32-200 -017-1119

- All household furniture, furnishings, appliences and personal effects contained in the aforementioned condominium;
- c. 1978 Chevrolet Monte Carlo.

ON MOTION OF COUNSEL FOR PETITIONER, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- 1. That a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage is entered in favor of both parties hereby dissolving their marriage.
- 2. That the care, custody, control and education of the minor child, JENNIFER J. SNOOK, is hereby awarded to Petitioner and

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reasonable visitation is accorded to Respondent.

- That Respondent shall pay, as and for the support of the minor child, the sum of \$65.00 per week through the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court. Said child support payments to commence upon the entry of this Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.
- That for so long as the Respondent has the obligation to support or contribute to the cost of the education of the minor child, Respondent shall pay for the cost of extra ordinary medical expenses and extra ordinary dental care of the child, which expense is not paid by the hospitalization or medical insurance of either of the parties. The Respondent at his sole expense shall obtain and maintain in full force and effect major medical and hospital insurance towards the foregoing purposes and shall provide the Petitioner with written evidence of the same and identification documents making the use of the insurance immediately available in an emergency.
- That for so long as Respondent has the obligation to support the minor child, Respondent shall obtain and maintain in full force and effect and pay or cause to be paid, the premiums as they become due of a life insurance policy on his life with a total face value of not less than \$30,000.00 and shall name the minor child as irrevocable beneficiary of said policy.
- That Petitioner is hereby awarded the following property as her own separate property, free and clear of any interest of Res-83-55 pondent thereto, to wit:
 - Sole and exclusive ownership of the marital residence located at 120 Boardwalk, Elk Grove Village. Illinois, legally described as follows:

Unit 120-5 in Boardwalk Condominium as delinated on survey of lots or parts thereof in Boardwalk Subdivision of Part of the North 15 acres of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 41 North, Range 11, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois, according to the plat thereof recorded as Document No. 21840416 in Cook County, Illinois, which survey is attached as Exhibit A to Declaration of Condominium Ownership made by National Bank of Austin, as Trustee under Trust No. 5160 recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, as Document No. 22-633-866, together with a precentage of the Common Elements Appurtenant to said unit as set forth in said Declaration, as amended from time to time.

All household furniture, furnishings, appliances and b. personal effects contained in the aforementioned marital

residence;

- c. 1978 Chevrolet Monte Carlo;
- d. That the Respondent is ordered to transfer and convey his interest in and to the aforesaid property to the Petitioner within ten (10) days from entry of this Judgment and that on Respondent's failure to do so, this Court will do so.
- 7. That Respondent shall indemnify and hold Petitioner harmless against liability arising out of the following:
 - Judgment entered against Respondent in favor of Mary L. Will in Case Number 82 Ml-112645 in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois;
 - b. Debts or obligations arising out of a business known as Dynamic Sports Hang-Gliding.
 - 8. That each parties claim for maintenance is barred.

9. That this Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Judgment.
